We have made few changes in our scheduling. This is designed to help promote your safety as well as the safety of our staff and other patients. Examples of these changes are:

- Our office will communicate with you before the appointment and ask some screening questions.

- Appointments will be managed to allow social distancing between patients by allowing greater time between patients and to reduce wait time and number of patients in reception area at any one time.
- We are offering Telehealth appointments to ensure that you receive care at the appropriate time and setting.
